








CLUBS

Tournament rules

- 1. A team consists of 10 players and 3 reserves. Rolling subs are allowed.
- 2. No place kicks for conversion (kicker to be given 30 seconds to kick)
- 3. Full line outs from point of touch
- 4. Scoring team kicks off to restart after a try has been scored
- 5. A starting line out must be made up as follows:
 - 5 Forwards (2 x props, hooker, 2 x locks)
 - 5 Backs (Scrumhalf, flyhalf, center, wing, fullback)
- 6. Games to start, and restart, with a kick-off.
- 7. No place kicks, just drop kicks.
- 8. ALL tackles below the shoulder.
- 9. Scrums and line-outs are contested.
- 10. No one to play in boots strictly no boots

11. U13:

- · Yellow card forced sub, and penalized player misses rest of game.
 - Red card no sub, penalized player out for all subsequent matches during the festival.

- Yellow card sin bin 2 minutes
- Red Card no sub, penalized player out for all subsequent matches during the festival.
- 12. Festival games will be 10 minutes per half, with a 2 minute half-time and a 5 minute changeover time
- 13. Event will be round robin structure and then a ranking playoff round
- 14. Win 3 points, Draw 1 point, Loss 0 points
- 15. Normal World rugby rules apply
